



## Categories:

### Performing/short video/film

— singing, acting, dancing, poetry reading, multi-media, original video/film, etc. Send DVD or VHS of performance.

**Visual Arts** — sculpture, painting, digital design or photography, needlework, pastels, drawings, etc. Securely attach entry form to art work.

**Written Expression** — original poetry, song lyrics, essays, scripts, etc. Submit on 11 x 14 sheet(s) of paper or smaller.

**Community Service** — may include any project that demonstrates Dr. King's goals and ideals. Submit 3-5 minute video or submit written portfolio.
