## ELIGIBILITY

- Open to students in grades K-12 who reside in either Kettering or Oakwood
- Students may enter as individuals or as a group
- Students may enter through their school, a community group or organization, a church group or simply as an individual
- Competition will be within four grade groups: K-2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>

## PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded in each age group - Exceptions include: Community Service 3-12<sup>th</sup> grade only, short video/film 6-12<sup>th</sup> grade only

- Judging will cover all categories of entries

## RULES FOR ENTRIES

- Entries must relate to Dr. King's life or teachings or vision.
- Visual Arts includes but is not limited to:
  - Drawings, paintings, digital photography, computer generated art
  - Needlework, handcrafts
  - Sculpture
  - Digital design
  - Any work too large to submit with entry blank, should be represented photographically
- Written Expression includes but is not limited to:
  - Essay, story, report
  - Original poetry
  - Original song lyrics
  - Speeches
  - Must not exceed 5 minutes of live presentation
- Performing arts includes but is not limited to:
  - Singing
  - Instrument
  - Acting
  - Dancing
  - Dramatic reading
  - Enter on DVD or VHS tape.
  - Must not exceed 5 minutes
- Community service or project
  - Written report of service or project
  - Video report of service or project
  - Must not exceed 5 minutes
